2023 WWC PGA PRO-MEMBER GUIDELINES

- 1. ELIGIBILITY: PGA Members: All active life members and active regular members are eligible. Current employment is not an eligibility requirement for members. Since active members who have left their jobs are still eligible to participate, they will also be subject to fines for late cancellation or no-shows. Members who become suspended or inactive will lose their remaining spots. Their prior facility may request to keep those spots for their other professionals. PGA Associates: Registered PGA Associates are eligible to play as long as they are currently employed or transferring to a new employer. Pro-Member spots for Associates who become suspended may be used by other professionals at their facility. Associates who leave eligible employment will lose their remaining spots until they resume eligible employment. Their prior facility may request to keep those spots for their other professionals. Amateurs: Amateurs must be 18 years of age or older, and from the professional's own club. If unable to secure 3 members, the playing professional should call the host professional. The host professional will try to help fill the foursome with players from the host club. If the host professional does not have players available, then the playing professional may bring amateurs from another club who have valid USGA handicaps.
- 2. TRANSFERS: Pro-member tee times may always be exchanged among in-house golf professionals. If, after the cancellation deadline, a professional needs to cancel their time at an event that is not full, the professional may find a replacement professional from any course to take their place, as long as that professional does not already have a spot in the field. If a professional leaves a position for another position in the Chapter, the tee times go with the professional.
- 3. <u>DRESS CODE</u>: Professionals and amateurs must abide by the dress code in effect at the host course. In addition, under <u>no</u> circumstances may professionals wear jeans of any style or color at any venue. Tailored golf shorts (including skirts or skorts) may be worn by professionals and amateurs alike. Specifically prohibited: cut-offs, cargo shorts or any baggy shorts with or without oversized pockets, short shorts, athletic shorts, and any type of exercise shorts. Players failing to meet this dress code will not be allowed to participate. It is the professional's responsibility to insure that his/her amateurs are advised of the dress code.
- 4. <u>REGISTRATION</u>: Each professional is responsible for the accuracy of their team's registration, including handicaps and GHIN #'s. Professionals must register their team of amateurs no later than 3:00pm <u>TWO DAYS</u> before the event. Those failing to register on time will be assessed a \$25 fine <u>NO EXCEPTIONS</u>. A payment link for the fine will be emailed to the professional the day after the event. All fines must be paid before a professional may participate in future events. *Missing a player?...register on time with a TBD to avoid the \$25 fine*.
- 5. <u>HANDICAP POLICY</u>: Amateurs must have an active USGA GHIN handicap to play in WWC events. On-line handicaps with virtual golf clubs will not be valid. A few exceptions are as follows:
 - a) Any amateur may play in an event with a 0.0 handicap index.
 - b) An amateur may play in an event if he/she has an inactive handicap that can be substantiated. This provision will allow the amateur to play one time, and he or she will be directed to get the handicap activated before playing in another event. All inactive handicaps will be reduced by 20%.
 - c) Guests invited as part of a sponsor team may play without a handicap, a conservative estimated handicap will be assigned by the executive director. The executive director has the right to assign a temporary handicap under special circumstances.

The maximum handicap index allowed is 36.0 for all players (men and women) in regular pro-member and senior pro-am events. Amateurs with higher indexes may participate, but will be limited to the maximum allowable index. All players play to 90% of their handicap for the team competition; 100% for the individual games, including closest to the hole contests.

6. SELECTING TEES: New for 2023

The Chapter will use 3 sets of tees for all events. All players may elect to play from any of the tee markers at an event (and must remain playing those tees for the duration of the round). If a player (male) chooses to play forward, he will be eligible for Net prizes only. Ladies will be allowed to play from any tee. If they play from the middle or back tee, they will gain handicap strokes and still be eligible for Gross and Net prizes. Example:

BLUE TEES (back) – Men: Gross & Net with no handicap change / Ladies: Gross & Net with handicap addition **WHITE TEES** (middle) – Men: Net Only with handicap reduction / Ladies: Gross & Net with handicap addition **RED TEES** (forward) – Men: Net Only with handicap reduction / Ladies: Gross & Net with no handicap change There will be no age restrictions for playing alternate tees.

7. STABLEFORD SCORING: New for 2023

All events in 2023 will utilize Stableford Points for scoring.

POINTS: Dbl Bogey & Higher-0 | Bogey-1 | Par-2 | Birdie-3 | Eagle-4 | Dbl Eagle-5

All players will be required to pick-up on a hole once they have reached a net score that will earn 0 points.

- 8. SCORING & PACE OF PLAY: Teams will be provided with one scorecard for all events in 2023. Official Scoring will be the Live Scoring provided through the Golf Genius App. Once a round is complete and scores have been recorded on each hole, teams are to check their ONLINE SCORECARD to be sure all holes have scores entered and those scores are correct. When you complete your 18th hole of the day, and enter your scores into the scoring app, all players will receive an email with their own scores for the day. From this point, all players have 15 minutes to confirm or correct their scores online with their professional. We will use the emails' time stamp to determine your finish time. Any group playing in over 4 hours and 40 minutes must finish inside of 15 minutes of the group ahead of them. If you play in 4:41 or more, and your round ending (email) time stamp is 16 minutes after the group ahead (or more), all players in the foursome will receive a 1-stroke penalty applied to hole #18.
- 9. <u>CANCELLATIONS</u>: Professionals will have access to cancel, change or add a tee time online using ForeTees. All changes must be made by the professional on ForeTees. A link to the tee sheets will be on the Chapter website or you can use the Chapter App. The Cancellation Deadline for any event is 3 weeks prior to the event.

10. <u>FINES</u>:

- a) Cancellations prior to 5:00 PM on the "Cancellation Deadline" date are not subject to a fine.
- b) Professionals cancelling after the "Cancellation Deadline" date will be fined \$100 + carts reserved, unless the event is played with a full field.
- c) Cancellations on the day of the event or a NO SHOW will result in a fine equal to the full team entry fee + carts reserved.
- d) Failure to register for an event by 3:00pm TWO DAYS prior to the event will result in a \$25 fine.
- e) Failure to record scores within 30 minutes of completeing play will result in a \$25 fine. If a professional does not record scores at all, they will be subject to the \$25.00 fine even if the card is a non-winning scorecard.
- f) Any of the fines above may be appealed in writing to the WWC Board of Directors within 10 days of receipt of a fine notification.

2023 Event Tee Time Allocation Process

ALLOCATION FORMS: There are 51 events to allocate tee times for in 2023. These include 31 Pro-Member events, the Patriot Golf Day Scramble, our two Pro-Junior events, 16 Senior Pro-Ams, and the Super Senior Mixer. With over 250 professionals expected to apply for tee times, the chance of receiving all of your top selections is very remote even for those in the highest priority. To ensure you get "enough" tee times be sure to list a priority for all courses you will play. Leave the priority box blank for the events you do not want to play.

Fill out the Allocation Form(s) with all requested information. You should prioritize the events you would like to play and return the completed form by email or mail to the chapter office no later than February 7, 2023. The sooner your allocation form is received, and your chapter dues have been paid, the higher the priority you will have within your priority level. Tee times will be allocated as described below and your received tee times will be available on ForeTees by February 17th.

<u>CHAPTER DUES</u>: You may go to <u>www.wwcpga.com</u> to pay your chapter dues by credit card or you may send a check to the chapter office. Your allocation form will not be accepted or prioritized until your 2023 WWC PGA Dues are paid in full.

PROFESSIONALS MUST SIGN-UP FOR & PLAY IN AT LEAST TWO \$60 AND/OR \$80 EVENTS

In order to participate in the tee time allocation process you must sign up for and play in at least TWO \$60 and/or \$80 events.

This can be two \$60 events, two \$80 events, or one of each. Please feel free to play in more that two!

Professionals who participate in the tee time allocation process and only play in one \$60/\$80 event will be invoiced for a full team entry of \$220. Professionals who participate in the tee time allocation process and do not play in any \$60/\$80 events will be invoiced for the full team entry of \$220 and an additional full team entry of \$280 after the last event of the season.

EXAMPLE FOR FILLING OUT ALLOCATION SHEET: Conceivably, you could number each event 1-32 with your number one priority being the course you would most like to play, number two the next, and so on. It is not necessary to prioritize every event. The more events you give a priority number to, the more events you will have a chance to receive times for, but please do not prioritize any courses you would not play. If you get a time at a course you decide you don't really want, please cancel it right away. Here's how the allocation process works:

- Round 1: Each professional receives 4 (2 then 2 in priority levels 1&2) times according to the listed priority below.
- Round 2: Each professional receives 4 additional times according to the priority below.
- Round 3: Each professional receives 4 additional times according to the priority below.
- Round 4: If any times remain; the staff will fill according to the priority below.

When assigning your courses during allocation, your first choice will be checked first. If a time is available, you will be given one. If your first choice is not available, your second choice will be checked and so on until you have been given four times in the first round. If you only list four courses with a priority, and one or more of them are not available, you may only receive two or three courses.

Priority Levels:

- #1 2023 Pro-Member HOST Head Professionals, General Managers, Directors of Golf, and PGA Member Superintendents
- #2 15 year PGA Members
- #3 PGA Member Head Professionals, General Managers, Directors of Golf, and PGA Member Superintendents
- #4 All additional HOST PGA Members
- #5 All other PGA Members
- #6 HOST PGA Associates
- #7 All other PGA Associates

Professionals within the same priority will be assigned allocations based on date of receipt of allocation form and dues.

DUNGENESS TWO-DAY & FALL FLING:

Use only one priority # for each of these events. Individual event dates for the Fall Fling will open if space is available after the cancellation deadline.

BRING TWO TEAMS TO AN EVENT:

A professional may bring two teams to a Pro-Member and will be given priority after all allocations have been awarded. **On your allocation sheet, mark "YES" in the Two Teams column for an event you wish to bring two teams**. If there are openings available at that event after allocations, you will be given back-to-back tee times for your two teams. Play 9 holes with the first group and fall back to the second group for your second 9 holes. Professionals pay one entry fee and may win team money with both teams.

NOTE: IF YOUR COURSE HOSTS A PRO-MEMBER, DO NOT GIVE IT A PRIORITY NUMBER.

Professionals are automatically given a tee time for an event at their own course.

2023 WWC PGA Senior Pro-Am Allocation Guidelines

We will begin the allocation process around February 10th. Priority is given on a first in / first awarded basis. There will be no other priorities established like in the regular pro-member events. We will go through the stack of forms in order received and grant each senior professional their top four selections, repeating this process until everybody receives all their picks or all the events fill. We will fill a waiting list for each event as well. Your tee times for 2023 will be available for you to review on ForeTees by February 17th.

Fill out the enclosed allocation form by prioritizing the events you would like to play and whether or not you would like to reserve golf carts. Email or mail the completed form to the chapter office no later than February 7, 2023. You will not be assigned a priority or allocated any tee times unless your chapter dues are paid.

Go to the chapter's homepage at www.wwcpga.com to pay your 2023 dues. You may pay online by credit card or mail a check to the chapter office. Please note the new Chapter Office address on the bottom of your forms.

Eligibility

Professionals must be at least 45 years old to play in all Senior Pro-Ams. Professionals must be Active Members, Life Members, or eligibly employed PGA Associates. Class F, suspended, or inactive members are not eligible. Amateurs must be age 50+.

Selecting Tees – New in 2023

The Chapter will use 3 sets of tees for all events. <u>All</u> players may elect to play from <u>any</u> of the tee markers at an event (and must remain playing those tees for the duration of the round). If a player (male) chooses to play forward, he will be eligible for Net prizes only. Ladies will be allowed to move back a tee (or two), gain handicap strokes, and she will still be eligible for Gross and Net prizes.

Example:

BLUE TEES (back) – Men: Gross & Net with no handicap change / Ladies: Gross & Net with handicap addition **WHITE TEES** (middle) – Men: Net Only with handicap reduction / Ladies: Gross & Net with handicap addition **RED TEES** (forward) – Men: Net Only with handicap reduction / Ladies: Gross & Net with no handicap change There will be no age restrictions for playing alternate tees.

Registration / Deadlines / Fines

The cancellation deadline for senior pro-ams is three weeks prior to the event. If you cancel after the deadline you will be fined \$100 + carts reserved (unless the event is played with a full field). If you cancel or no-show on the day of the event you will be fined the team entry of \$230 + carts reserved.

<u>LATE REGISTRATION FINE</u> - Professionals must register their team of amateurs no later than 3:00pm TWO DAYS before the event. Those failing to register on-time will be assessed a \$25 fine.

Entry Fees

The total team entry is \$230. Amateurs pay \$60 / Professionals pay \$50 which includes skins.

<u>COMPETE AS AN INDIVIDUAL IN BOTH DUAL EVENTS</u> –

- a) When playing in a "Dual Event" a professional playing with a "Senior Pro-Am Team" may choose to play as an individual in the Regular Pro-Member for an additional \$50 entry (\$100 total).
- b) When playing in a "Dual Event" a professional playing with a "Regular Pro-Member Team" may choose to play as an individual in the Senior Pro-Am for an additional \$60 entry (\$100 total).
- c) You will earn Hagen Cup and North/South Cup points only if you participate in both events.

Golf Carts

In the cart column on the allocation form, please circle the 1 or 2 depending on the number of carts you require. Leave this blank if you do not require carts. Carts may not be available if you do not request them. Changes to cart reservations must be made by the event's cancellation deadline. If you have a cart(s) reserved after the cancellation date you will be required to pay for it/them; this applies even if you cancel, do not play, and pay the fine.
